Graphic Products is concerned both with visual imagery and the production of 3-D outcomes. You will use a wide range of graphic techniques to create, develop and communicate solutions to problems. The solutions are modelled in compliant materials to convey 3-D concepts to others. You would also learn how to use a variety of Industrial software.



Assessment is split between controlled assessment consisting of a concise design folder, ICT evidence and a 3-D outcome (60% of the final grade) and an end of course written examination (40%) that tests knowledge and understanding of the key aspects of the course -materials, components, processes, techniques, technologies and evaluation of commercial practices and graphic products.

Pupils can go on to do A Levels in a variety of Art and Design courses (Graphics, Fashion, Architecture, Product Design, Photography etc). BTEC National Diplomas in Art and Design, Design 3D, Fashion and Multi media.

Jobs and careers you could go into are, Graphic Designer, Web Designer, Freelance, Technician, Teachers, Product Designer Architect and many more.
