

GCSE Statistics

1 Year Course

Equivalent to 1 GCSE A* - G

Written paper 75%

Controlled Assessment 25%

This course offers a programme of study that gives candidates the opportunity to develop their knowledge and understanding of statistical thinking and practice, and an understanding of how statistics are used in the real world.

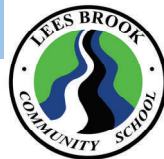
The courses will develop skills in the following areas:

- Planning a strategy when completing an investigation
- Data collection including sampling methods and the use of census data
- Tabulation and representation of results
- Analysis of data including measures of spread, time series, correlation and regression
- Probability
- Interpretation of data including limitations of analysis

This course is suitable for any student achieving a high grade pass in GCSE Mathematics

The skills and knowledge acquired will be relevant and transferable to other settings and will enhance career opportunities. The course provides direct progression to Advanced level Mathematics and Statistics as well as supporting the techniques used in a wide variety of other subjects, for example Advanced level Sciences and Geography
