

## Lees Brook Young Sports Leader

During the two year course you will do;

- **National Governing Body Young Leader Awards**  
e.g. Junior Football Organiser, Junior Netball Organiser, Cricket Young Leader and Badminton Young Leader
- **Work Experience or work related activity to sport.**  
This would be within Lees Brook and local primary schools (e.g. leading sports festivals for younger pupils or by being a classroom assistant in PE or Dance) working with Derby County in the Community, Breadsall Priory or using facilities at Derby College
- **25 voluntary hours of sport either within school or within the community.**  
This could be helping PE/Dance with clubs and activities at lunchtime/after school or assisting a local community club in evenings or at the weekend with coaching of younger children in your favourite sport

What should I do next if I have answered 'yes' to the questions?

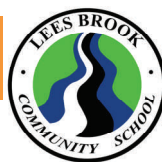
