This Course is for school learners who wish to join the automotive Industry.

This is a work-based automotive qualification that assesses the competence and knowledge that service technicians require to perform their job role effectively. These technicians will work on light vehicles (cars and vans) in all types of garages, dealerships and maintenance depots.

Students will work offsite for one full day a week and will learn how to carry out a wide range of maintenance tasks on cars and vans. This includes work on the main engine, gearbox, clutch and brakes.

When the Level 2 Apprenticeship is completed, an apprentice can progress to a level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship, or broaden their education and training in other ways from this firm base. From this you can go on to: IMI* Awards Level 4, Management VQs**, Gain credit for entry onto a Higher Diploma, or degree and many more

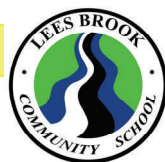
