In September, we are looking to launch a Young Ambassador initiative in school. This will first be trialled with the current Year 7's, who are moving into Year 8. It is similar to the idea that other schools have with Head Boy and Girls. The idea is for the students to be involved in the community of the school and they will be given the opportunity to make a difference in the school's future and progress.

The role will involve mentoring other students in school, representing the school at events and being involved in the recruitment process in school, to name just a few responsibilities.
