Dear Parent

Welcome back to the new academic year. The summer always flies by and it seems like we have never been away. We have made an extremely positive start to the academic year and we are looking forward to a very busy and exciting year ahead.

I am absolutely thrilled with our outcomes this year. Lees Brook is the most improved school in the city. Overall, 63% of students achieved a standard pass in English and Maths and 40% achieved a strong pass in both subjects. This is a significant improvement from last year. In particular, the English results have been outstanding, 76% of all students achieved a 4 or above and 60% of students achieved 5 or higher in English Language or Literature.

This year we have achieved our highest ever number of grade 9 results, a grade 9 is the highest grade possible and means that the student performed within the top 5% nationally. There were over 20 across all the students in the summer, however since requesting remarks, the number of grade 9s has increased further to 25. Fifteen of these grade 9s were in English and Maths.

Students in Dance and Art achieved some outstanding results, with 30% of students achieving between a grade 7 and 9. Media studies again was successful with 29% of students achieving an A or A*. This outstanding success was achieved in a wide selection of subject areas, over 20% of students achieved grades 7 – 9 in History and over 80% achieved a level 4 or above in German. There have been significant improvements in outcomes throughout the school.

I want to say a huge thank you to all the staff for their hard work and commitment, parents for their continued and valued support and most of all to our fantastic students who have worked exceptionally hard and of whom we are extremely proud. The hard work put in by everybody has led to an outstanding set of GCSE results.
