Vocabulary	Definition
Cross-infection	Where the carrier of a disease passes it to somebody else.
Dressing product	Applied to dry hair. Use to define and set the finished look
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)	Equipment available for use in the workplace to protect you, your skin and clothes from damage
Professional image	Presenting yourself well in the salon including following rules for dress code and using positive body language
Sanitisation	To make hygienic and clean by destroying most micro organisms
Sterilisation	The complete destruction of living organisms to prevent cross infection
Styling product	Applied to wet hair. Used to aid the moulding and drying stage of a set or blow dry.

Structure of a single hair	
Hair cuticle	The outermost layer of the hair made up of overlapping scales of keratin.
Cortex	The main layer in the structure of the hair which lies under the cuticle.
Medulla	This is the middle section of the hair . The medulla does not have a function and is not always present.
