10.00- 11.00am Pupils will have the opportunity to walk round the zoo and visit the animals in small groups/pairs. **Ensure you have appropriate footwear and clothing**

12.30pm Lunch meeting point– **PUPILS MUST BRING A PACKED LUNCH OR MONEY TO PURCHASE FOOD.**

Pupils on free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch.

1.00pm- 2.00pm Continue exploring the area in small groups/pairs

2.30pm – bus departs Twycross and travels back to school. **PUPILS WILL BE DISMISSED FROM LEES BROOK COMMUNITY SCHOOL ON RETURN AT APPROXIMATELY 4.00pm.**

Please ensure your child has appropriate footwear and clothing as this event will be mainly based outside. Pupils can bring spending money if they wish but they will be responsible for this.

Please complete the consent form located in the forms section of your parent mail account by MONDAY 13<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2022 to confirm your child's place. If you wish your child to stay in school on that day, learning will resume and classes will be collapsed.
