Dear parents & carers,

Year 11 football fixtures

I am pleased to inform you that your child has been selected for the Year 11 football team, to represent the school next half term. The team has qualified for the playoff stages of the league by finishing top of the group stage prior to October half term.

The fixtures will kick off at approximately 3.45pm and finish approximately at 5.15pm, depending on travel time we will return to school at approximately 5.30pm. This will be a fantastic opportunity to compete against all the other secondary school in the city.

At present the team have the following fixtures scheduled for next half term.

- Tuesday 7th March: Home match opposition to be confirmed
- Tuesday 14th March: Final or 3-4 place
- Thursday 23rd March: 9 a side tournament

On Thursday 23rd March for the 9 a side tournament and in order for the team to take part students will leave the school site as normal at 2.00pm and then return to school at 3.15pm. The tournament will start at 3.30pm and finish at approximately 5.00pm

What to Wear

Students should bring with them footwear appropriate for the grass pitches, shinpads and Lees Brook PE kit, additionally pupils are advised to bring tracksuit bottoms and a warm coat to wear whilst the students are not playing matches. Please ensure they have a still drink (no energy drinks) and snack with them.

Consequences for poor behaviour in such a public environment will be very serious and we will revoke an invitation from students who show poor behaviour in school prior to the event: you will be contacted if this applies to your child.
