Travel

On the day parking is limited at the venue, so only the school mini buses and disabled spectators will be able to park at the Reach Centre. Any parents/spectators will need to park at Derby Arena.

We will be taking the students in the school mini bus and bringing them back to school after the show. It is parents/carers responsibility to arrange students get home from school.

What to Wear/Bring

Students should bring with them their red top and black leggings for the performance and Lees Brook PE jumper to keep warm when not performing, Please ensure they have a still drink (no energy drinks) with them and a snack if they wish as no food is provided at the venue.

Tickets
