Year 9 Curriculum Choice (Options) Information Evening – Tuesday 14th March 6pm – 8pm

As your child is currently in Year 9, they have begun the process of deciding which subjects they wish to study at Key Stage 4 in Years 10 and 11. This is called the 'Curriculum Choice Programme'. As part of this process, your child has been involved in the Year 9 Careers day, which supported their understanding of the different pathways available to them after Year 11. They have also completed weekly careers sessions, which has allowed them to develop their knowledge and enabled your child to complete a draft curriculum choice to express an interest in studying certain subjects for their Key Stage 4 studies in September 2023.

In order to help make their final choices, there will be a Curriculum Choice Information Evening for all Year 9 students and their parents on **Tuesday 14**th **March 6pm-8pm**. During this evening staff from all curriculum areas will be available at this event to discuss the courses being offered in more detail so that your child will be able to make an informed decision about the curriculum they would like to study in Key Stage 4.

In addition, there will be an opportunity to attend a short talk about the curriculum structure and the curriculum choice process being offered and the progression routes available following completion of Year 11. This will take place at 6pm and repeated at 7pm in the main hall.
