# **Year 11 Revision**

I hope that this letter finds you and your family safe and well. It is hard to believe that we are already into the third week of this term, but for your child they are entering their final two terms at Lees Brook. With their GCSE exams in the Summer Term, they will have a second set of mock exams the first two weeks after February half term to support them in their preparation and revision.

Please do talk with your child about the importance of these mock exams and that revising for them consistently and effectively will support them in the long-term with their GCSEs in the summer term.

# What are we doing as an academy to support your child?

There are a number of strategies and resources we have shared with students to support your child:

- Science of Learning sessions, including how to revise and how to create a revision timetable, have been delivered to Year 11 students on Student Inset Days in September and January. As such, every student who attended these days should now have a draft revision timetable. Please do ask them about this.
- Students are receiving fortnightly 'How to revise' assemblies, focusing on strategies such as Plan, Do, Review. This is where students plan the revision they will complete 'do' the revision using the highlighted strategies, and then review their learning using exam questions or knowledge quizzes to check they can remember and understand the content. Going forward, these will include revision strategies and managing exam stress to support student mental health.
- A Microsoft Teams has been set up where students can access their lesson resources they have been taught in school, using these to support their revision. This was previously shared in the 'Quality of Education Update' letter in December. - A 'How to revise' help sheet was provided in every student pack at Year 11 Subject Evening. These are also available in the Main Reception at the academy.
- Tutor revision sessions take place every week.

## What can your child do to be proactive with their revision?

Your child should ensure they have finalised their revision timetable and be sticking to this each week. Students should ensure they build in time to rest and take breaks, spend time with family and friends. However, the time spent revising from this point forward should be substantial to ensure they achieve the very best that they can. Their mock results support students in college, apprenticeship and Post-16 applications so their very best effort is essential.

Students can ask or email their teachers for resources, access the Microsoft Teams resources, use the revision guides and ensure they attend revision and study support sessions. Ultimately, while we as teachers and parents are there to support them, these are their GCSEs and the responsibility is theirs to ensure they are proactive in their revision from this point onwards.
